

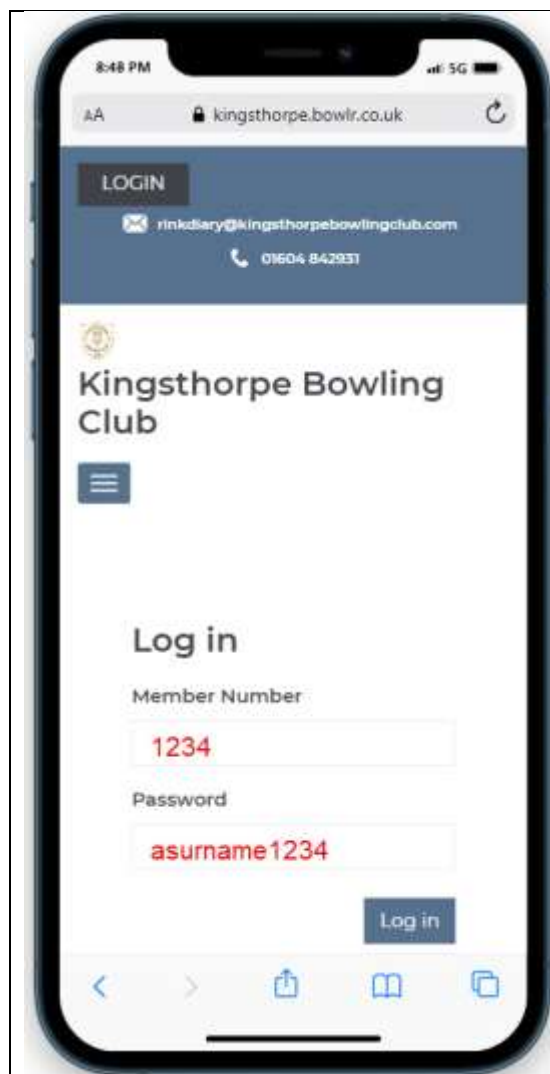


Indoor Bowlr

The attached guidelines, with screenshots taken from a smartphone, are intended to help you navigate your way around the main Indoor Bowlr heading from your smartphone.

Using Bowlr, members can make rink bookings, view league tables, check members' contact details and access important communications and information from the club.

Bowlr is a member-only system; members of the public cannot access club information from our club website.



This will be the first page you see on Bowlr

To login

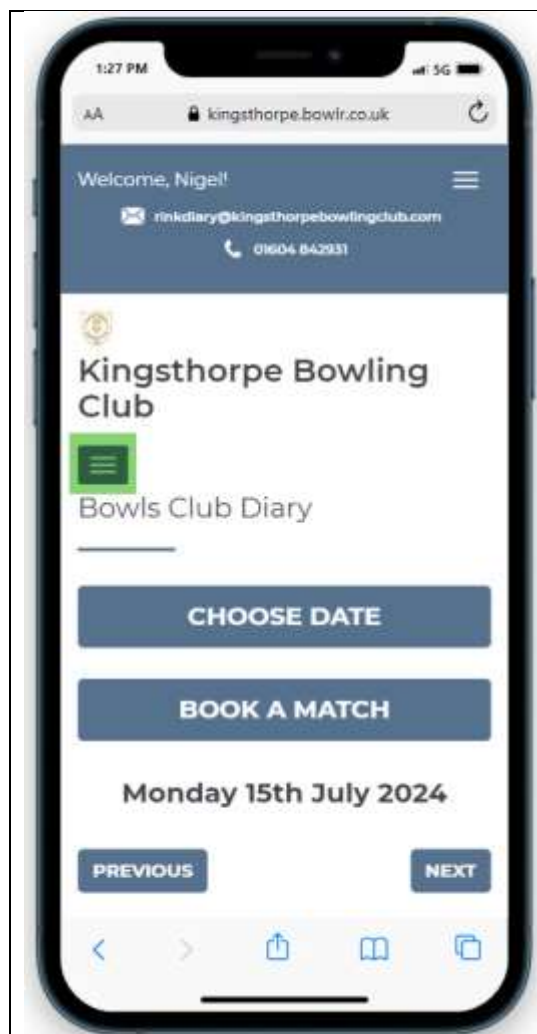
Enter your **membership number**

Enter your **password** which will be the initial of your first name, followed by your surname, and your membership number (all lowercase)

Press the Login Button, there will be a slight delay,

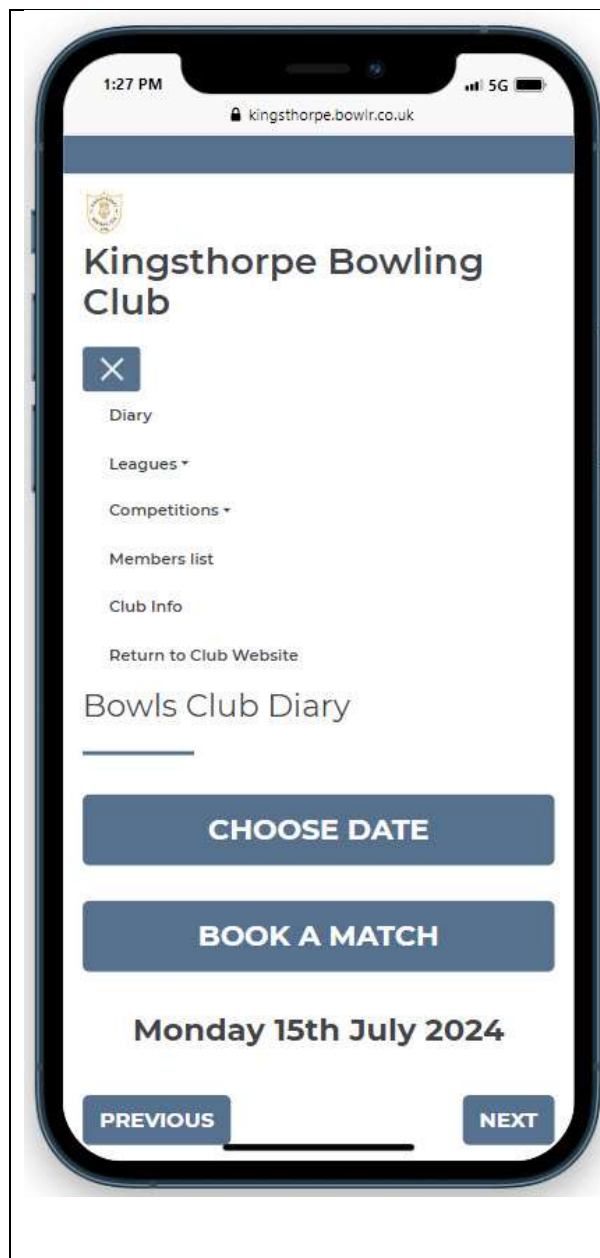
The next screen you see will often be the last one viewed from your previous login. (often the screen displayed on page 4)

However, to view all the options available in Bowlr, view the guidelines on the next page.



After you have logged on to Bowlr, look for the **menu button** below the wording **Kingsthorpe Bowling Club**

The menu button will display the six options available to you as a member (see image on next page).



Diary - Is where you go to book your rinks and check rink availability

Leagues - Will display a drop-down menu of all the leagues.

Select the league you wish to view; this will display the league table, fixture list and previous match results.

Competitions - Will display a drop-down menu of all current competitions. Select the competition to view progress.

Members List – Will take you to the membership contact details.

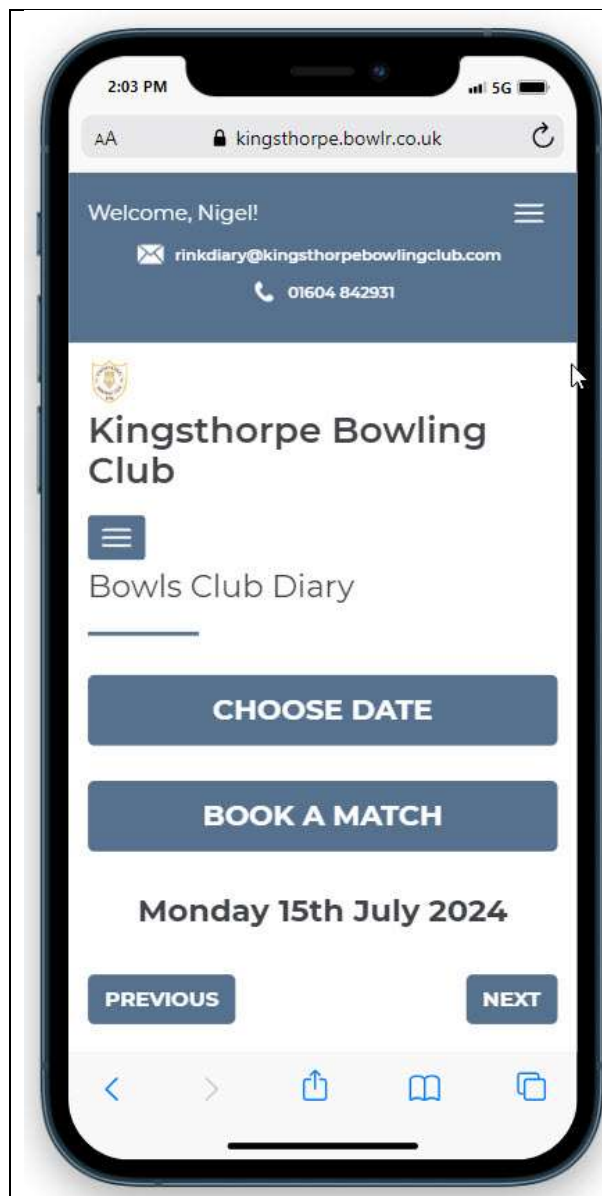
Use the Search feature to find the person you wish to contact; Select to reveal more contact details.

Club Info - Select to reveal a drop-down which will be a mixture of important club messages, social diary and much more.

** The Club Info area is a much unused, but extremely useful, drop-in point for members **

Return to Club Website - Will take you to the main KBC website.

The website is an important source of information both for club members and the public.



The **Rink Diary** page will be the one that members use the majority of the time to make bookings.

It will often be the first page you see after login.



This is a typical view of the Club Info page

Click on any of the headings in the drop-down menu to view the appropriate page giving you more detail on the chosen topic.

This serves as the primary communication channel, in addition to direct email, for sharing information and updates with the membership.

This page is constantly updated so regular viewing is recommended
